
Skills First Funding

Certificate IV in Massage Therapy

Opening the way to a new course in your life.

This is where you open the door to your Massage Therapy career. The Certificate IV in Massage Therapy (HLT42015) is the entry qualification you need to be recognised as a professional Massage Therapist.

We will give you the opportunity to gain the skills you will need to work as a Massage Therapist by teaching you practical massage skills, human anatomy, pathology and first aid.

Relaxation Massage

The increasing pace and stress of today's life means more people are seeking out Graduates with this speciality for their skills in calming, nurturing and healing. Relaxation is something of a signature for massage – everyone thinks of it first (the quick neck rub) and it is one of the oldest uses of massage. It is particularly attractive to many people because of its non-invasive, gentle, totally natural approach. The special massage techniques you will learn are designed to stimulate the body's own defences against the ravages of stress.

Also included is "seated" massage techniques to use in the dynamic growth area of the corporate massage industry, plus the added skills of pregnancy massage and clinical relaxation techniques.

Accreditation

MIMT is a Registered Training Organisation with the Australian Skills & Qualifications Authority. This course is Nationally Recognised (Course code HLT42015).



Professional Accreditation

This course is recognised by various professional associations including Massage & Myotherapy Australia (M&MA), Association of Massage Therapists (AMT) & Massage Association Australia (MAA).

Course Prerequisites

The Certificate IV in Massage Therapy has no pre-requisites.

Class Times

The course may be taken either full time over six months or part time over ten months. Alternatively, we also offer a blended online learning option.

Full time study is from 9.30am until 4.15pm and normally attendance is required 3 days a week

Part time study is from 6.30pm until 9.30pm two evenings per week and one weekend per month (Saturday & Sunday 9.30am until 4.15pm).

Optional online learning enables you to study the health science component of the Certificate course from your own home. You will receive an identical presentation as that in the classroom.

You can study at your own pace. With email and on line tutorials you are fully supported through the modules.

You are only required to attend class for the massage hands on units and assessments which are programmed at various times throughout the year.

SUBJECT DESCRIPTIONS

Body Organisation

The aim of this module is to develop in students:

- An appreciation of the complexity and functional effectiveness of the body in contributing to human survival
- An understanding of the basic general structure of the human body at both microscopic and gross levels
- The ability to describe regions of the body using elementary anatomical terms

Musculoskeletal Anatomy

The aim of these modules is to develop in students:

- A recognition of the roles of bones, joints and muscles in relation to human movement
- Motivation for further learning in the fields of anatomy and kinesiology (human movement)
- The knowledge and skill required to relate theoretical anatomy of bones, muscles and joints to clinical massage work and thus to recognize all structures palpated during massage

Systemic Anatomy & Physiology

The aim of this module is to develop in students:

- An understanding of the physiological capabilities and contribution of each of the body systems and of the organization and anatomical structures pertaining to each of those systems
- An appreciation of the beauty and subtlety of the human body
- An understanding of ageing & chronic disease

Massage & Massage Principles

- Versatility in being able to apply these skills in non-clinical situations e.g home, travel or the workplace
- An awareness of common conditions for which massage is contraindicated or where particular precautions should be observed

Business Subjects:

Practical Components:

Reflexology for Relaxation

• Deals with the principle that there are reflex areas in the feet and hands which correspond to all the glands, organs and parts of the body, from a remedial perspective.

Lymphatic Drainage

• Provides students with specific techniques in a particular sequence aimed at moving lymphatic fluid through the body.

Musculoskeletal Assessment

 Develop in students the ability to perform a physical assessment appropriate for patients presenting for remedial massage. This unit looks at making a different diagnosis of soft tissue dysfunction.

 Covers the physiology of connective tissue fascia and teaches techniques to release tissue restrictions throughout the entire body.

Advanced Diploma of Myotherapy

Become a Myotherapist

The Advanced Diploma of Myotherapy gives you the opportunity of further enhancing the clinical and treatment skills attained at the Diploma of Remedial Massage level.

Additional to the remedial massage skills learnt in the Diploma, the Myotherapy student uses treatment regimes and clinical orthopaedic assessments to enhance the overall treatment plan.

Subjects such as myofascial dry needling, therapeutic exercise prescription, nutrition, electrotherapy and business management subjects increase the skills of the remedial therapist. The course emphasises the assessment and treatment of myofascial dysfunction.

Myotherapists use a range of treatment techniques with the aim of restoring and maintaining the integrity of soft tissue.

The graduate of the Advanced Diploma of Myotherapy would expect to work in a multi-disciplinary clinic environment.

The Myotherapy career pathways are endless!

The Advanced Diploma of Myotherapy is made up of twelve stand alone subjects. The pre requisite for this course is a Diploma of Remedial Massage*.

The Advanced Diploma modules are available fulltime with a course duration of 10 months.

FUNDING

Skills First funding is available for eligible students. Full time study is Austudy/ Abstudy/ Youth Allowance approved. (This training is delivered with Victorian & Commonwealth Government funding).

Upon completion of all of the units of competency you will be awarded the Advanced Diploma of Myotherapy (22316VIC) qualification.

SUBJECT OUTLINE

Myofascial Clinical Assessment (MCA)

This unit further develops the practitioner's soft tissue assessment skills ensuring that all assessment and treatment protocols reflect a comprehensive range of testing to isolate the client's dysfunction.

Myotherapy Palpation Review (MPR)

This subject reviews the structures of the body so that enhanced palpation skills are utilized to ensure specific soft tissue dysfunctions are identified and appropriate myotherapy protocols determined.

Nutrition (N)

This detailed subject covers important concepts relating to how the human organism interacts with its food. There is an emphasis on nutritional assessment, dietary problems and special dietary needs. The subject also covers nutrition for athletic performance and a range of nutritional conditions.

Research Methods (RM)

Research is the hallmark of a professional industry. In this subject the student will evaluate relevant research information and apply their findings to a myotherapy clinical practice.

Electrotherapeutic Modalities (EM)

This subject focuses on the understanding and appropriate use of electrotherapy modalities. The two main modalities cover both the electromagnetic and acoustic methods. The student will use transcutaneous electro nerve stimulators and muscle stimulators. Students will have a thorough understanding of pain and the benefits of electrotherapy in treatment.

Exercise Prescription and Rehabilitation (EPAR)

The student will learn a range of specific exercises to address a client's condition. With a thorough knowledge of anatomy, physiology and specialized knowledge of various pathologies, mechanisms of injury and tissue healing, the student will be able to establish exercise rehabilitation protocols.

Myofascial Dry Needling & Infection Control (MDN)

Based on the work of Travell & Simmons, myofascial dry needling involves the insertion of needles to de-activate myofascial trigger points, alleviate pain and increase range of movement. There is also a strong emphasis on infection control. This unit is based on trigger points and should not be confused with acupuncture.

Muscle Energy Technique (MET)

The use of "Hold/Relax/Strain & Counterstrain" stretches to bring about correction of spinal deviations.

Mobilising Techniques (MOB)

Enables students to extend the effectiveness of their treatment through the use of techniques which facilitate access to and loosening of deeper soft tissues.

Myotherapy Business Protocol (MBP)

This unit covers business planning, budgeting, leadership in the workplace and strategic management. It gives the student a much deeper understanding and appreciation of business practices.

Myotherapy Principles & Protocols (MPP)

Provides the skills and knowledge that enables the student to work effectively within a myotherapy framework and to review and advance the essential principles of assessment & treatment learnt from the Diploma of Remedial Massage.

Myotherapy Treatment Practices (MTP)
